

ORDINANCE #1460

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 111 OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HADDON ENTITLED "FEES"**

WHEREAS, the Township of Haddon ("Township") is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 111 of the Township Code sets forth various fees related to municipal services, including the production of documents related to the Open Public Records Act, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to establish an administrative fee for the production of Body Worn Camera footage to offset the cost of producing same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Board of Commissioners is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Township by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Township of Haddon, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 111, Section 3 of the Code of the Township of Haddon, entitled, "Fees for public records from Chapter 26," is hereby amended, revised, and supplemented as follows:

§ 113-3 Fees for public records from Chapter 26.

- C. If the nature, format, manner of collation, or volume of a government record embodied in the form of printed matter is such that the record cannot be reproduced by ordinary document copying equipment in ordinary business size or involves an extraordinary expenditure of time and effort to accommodate the request, then a special service charge shall be assessed in addition to the actual cost of duplication. The requestor shall have the opportunity to review and object to the charge in advance. These fees are as follows:
 - 1. Special labor charge for police officer review and redaction of body-worn camera video: \$0.49 per minute of time spent in review.

SECTION 2: Except as set forth in Section 1 above, the balance of the Code of the Township of Haddon shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 4: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of

judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.


